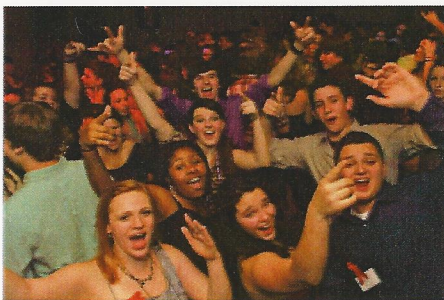
Expressive Elocution (<http://www.storytime-theater.com/expressive-elocution.html>)
